CONSERV MUCC

STEP 1: IDEA

What problem concerning hunting, fishing, trapping or the conservation of our natural resources do you want to solve?

STEP 2: WRITE A RESOLUTION

State the problem in a series of "whereas" clauses, then your proposed solution in a "Therefore be it resolved" clause. MUCC staff can help you draft your resolution by emailing policystaff@mucc.org.

STEP 3: INTRODUCE YOUR RESOLUTION

Resolutions can be introduced either at a regional meeting or a quarterly Conservation Policy Board meeting.

STEP 4: ANNUAL CONVENTION

If the delegates representing MUCC clubs and individual members approve your resolution (requiring 2/3 support for a change in law or regulation) it becomes official MUCC policy.

STEP 5: IMPLEMENTATION

Once your idea becomes MUCC policy, our staff, members, partners and supporters work to implement your idea, including passing a law, changing a wildlife or fisheries regulation, or educating the public.

PATH TO POLICY
RESOLUTION

*Resolutions can be presented during your regional meetings to be approved and introduced to the next quarterly Conservation Policy Board meeting. Resolutions can also be presented at a Conservation Policy Board meeting directly. If accepted during a Conservation Policy Board meeting, your policy will advance to the Annual Convention.
